




66 MICHELE SERRA THE OLD MAN AND THE DOG STORY OF A FRIENDSHIP

The story begins with the sudden appearance of a dog outside the old man's house and ends when the man, after several weeks, finally manages to touch him. The main plot proceeds alongside the dreams of the old man and the dog, and occasionally crossing the relationship between the old man and his niece, Lucilla, who nicknamed the dog "Bone".

He was not only the director of the movie, but also the subject writer and the screenplayer. Cinema Paradiso was then followed by many other successfull movies like: A pure formality (1994), The Legend of the Pianist on the Ocean (1998), Malèna (2000), Unknown (2006), Baaria (2009), The Best Offer (2013) e The Correspondence (2016).















VIVIAN LAMARQUE, born in Tesero (Trento) in 1946, has always lived in Milan where she has taught Italian to foreigners and literature in private institutes. She has published Teresino (1981), The Golden Man (1986), Poesie dando del lei (1989), Il signore degli spaventati (1992), Una guieta polvere (1996). In 2002 her poems were collected in the Oscar Poesie Anthology 1972-2002. Afterwards, she published Poesie per un gatto (2007) and La gentilèssa (2009). Lamarque won numerous awards, including the Viareggio Opera Prima (1981), the Pen Club (1996) and the Andersen Award (2000). She is the author of about forty fairy tales translated into various languages, and of the poetry collections called Poesie di ghiaccio, and Poesie della notte. Lamarque also worked as a translator of authors like Valéry, Baudelaire, La Fontaine. In 2013, she released Gentilmente Milano, an anthology of articles published in the Corriere della Sera, one of the Italian most famous newspapers.







A beautiful illustrated book to tell young readers about the beauties of the sea, reminding them that even seas and oceans need to be cared for and respected.

Who better than Giovanni Soldini, expert sailor, famous for his solo crossings around the world, and winner of the 2019 Multihull Line Honours of the Royal Ocean Racing Club, can accompany us on this journey?

The children will learn stories, fun facts and specific characteristics of some areas of our planet touched by sea waters, with a focus on biodiversity and underwater life.

Giovanni Soldini's sea voyages will be the starting point for this journey (for example the Hong Kong-London crossing, the New York-San Francisco Gold Route, Cadiz-San Salvador etc.). The book will be enriched with seafaring notions and many tips on how to take care of our planet and in particular the sea, too often exploited and used as the rubbish bin of civilization.

GIOVANNI SOLDINI was born in Milan on May 16, 1966 and started sailing as a child. He has 25 years of racing experience, including two solo world tours (the Around Alone, won in 1999 and gone down in history for the rescue of Isabelle Autissier, and the 1995 Boc Challenge, where he qualified second overall), six Québec-Saint Malo (one victory in the monohull category), six Ostar (two victories, 50' and 40' class), three Transat Jacques Vabre (one victory in the 40 'class) and more than 40 transoceanic crossings.



66 ITALY. A STORY IN 15 ITINERARIES FOR KIDS (OF ALL AGES)

An illustrated journey to tell readers about Italy through 15 unusual itineraries suitable for all ages, including lesser-known places and with a particular geographical and tourist approach. The itineraries will cross one or more regions and you can choose yours based on the type of trip / traveller you are (for example, the adventurous, the daring, the artist ...), or the type of attractions you'd like to see (for example, underground routes, film settings, alternative houses such as trulli, trabocchi, cave-houses ...). For each macro-theme, 3-4 specific itineraries will be developed with an initial map showing the complete route and the most interesting points, and 2-3 in-depth studies of the surrounding area (the unmissable museum, the park to see etc.).

Itinerary Example

The underground locations It starts from the Italian region of Marche, and specifically from the city of Urbino, where you visit the aqueduct of Santa Lucia; then continue towards Ancona to witness the marvelous Frasassi caves. Reach Orvieto to discover St Patrick's well and its 248 steps staircase; the last stop is in Lazio, in Rome: here the little ones will be amazed by the three underground floors of the Baths of Caracalla.

Along the way, there will also be the chance to visit the surroundings areas of the places. For example, on the road between Ancona and Orvieto you can stop at the Tree Park in Jesi for an adventure in an educational farm, or once you arrive in Rome you can visit the Explora children's museum.




